

Furthermore, the second problems to answer the reason of using taboo utterances; the researcher used theory from Anderson and Trudgill (1990). The result of the reason using taboo utterances, the writer found psychological reason with (49%), linguistics reason with (41%), and social reason with (10%). From the percentage the writer find out that in this movie the reason of using taboo utterances is Psychological reason. According to Anderson and Trudgill (1990) psychological reason is words that reflect or show feelings of anger, sadness, disappointment, and surprise. It is very natural who feeling by someone and the words were uttered without any plan.

5.2 Suggestions

This research focused on the study of English taboo utterances used by main characters in American comedy movie *Tropic Thunder*. This research was expected to give contribution toward developing knowledge in sociolinguistics.

This research is expected to be useful for the students, especially in English language and literature department, because it provides empirical data to increase the student's knowledge in taboo words. The writer hopes that this study can help the next writer to further develop this research. In addition, the next researcher can use this knowledge by comparing English taboo with taboo words in Indonesian. In the future, the writer hopes that the next writers can use other methods such as the theory form Montangu or Wardhaugh. The writer also hopes for the next writer can use other media such as novels, music, or everyday conversation.
