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

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
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
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ABSTRACT

Key word: Conversation Analysis, Main Characters, Donald Duck, Comic

The writer analyzes conversation styles and language functions that are used by the main characters in Donald Duck Walt Disney comic who are Donald Duck and his nephews (Kwik, Kwek, and Kwak). The significance of the study is to help the speaker and the listener understand about the conversation in terms of the styles and functions in order to make the conversation easier to understand. The study applies Yule's theory about conversation styles and Cook's about language functions. The objective of this study is to find out the conversation styles and language functions used by the main characters in Donald Duck comic.

Qualitative research method is used in this because the data analyzed are in the forms of words rather than numbers. The data source of this study is the English comic of Donald Duck published in **26th edition**. The data for this study are taken from the utterances of the main characters in Donald Duck comic.

This study shows that the main characters use two kinds of conversation styles, namely high involvement style and high considerateness style. Based on the finding the conversation style often used is **high involvement style** because the comic tells about the bank robbery which needs some investigation and searching process of the bank robbers. Therefore, the main characters often do the conversation fast, with almost no pausing. Meanwhile, **high considerateness style** is used when there is investigation involving Donald as a witness in the court. He does not give his testimony in the first court when uttering with longer pauses. The language functions which are often used in Donald Duck is referential function because in the comic tells about the bank robbers that need the information in the investigation process.

The writer suggests for the next researcher to analyze different objects such as novels or films to enrich the theory about conversation styles and language functions.

ABSTRAK

Penulis menganalisis gaya percakapan dan fungsi bahasa yang digunakan oleh peran utama dalam komik *Donald Duck Walt Disney* mereka adalah Donald Duck dan ketiga ponannya (Kwik, Kwek, dan Kwak). Pentingnya meneliti studi ini untuk memudahkan pembicara dan pendengar memahami gaya percakapan dan fungsi bahasa agar lebih mudah untuk memahaminya. Studi ini menerapkan Yule teori dalam gaya percakapan dan Cook dalam fungsi bahasa. Tujuan dalam penelitian ini untuk menemukan gaya percakapan dan fungsi bahasa yang digunakan dalam komik Donald Duck.

Penelitian kualitatif adalah metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini. Penelitian ini digolongkan sebagai metode kualitatif karena data analisis yang digunakan berupa kata-kata dari pada angka. Sumber data studi ini menggunakan komik Bahasa Inggris yang dipublikasikan pada edisi ke 26.

Berdasarkan analisis penelitian ini, peran utama menggunakan dua macam gaya percakapan yaitu *high involvement style* dan *high considerateness style*. Berdasarkan penemuan tersebut gaya percakapan yang sering digunakan adalah *high involvement style* karena komik ini menceritakan tentang perampokan pada sebuah bank yang memerlukan penyelidikan dan proses pencarian pada pelaku perampokan tersebut. Maka dari itu, peran utama sering menggunakan percakapan relatif cepat, hampir tidak ada jeda pada setiap giliran yang diucapkan. Sedangkan *high considerateness style* digunakan untuk menyelidiki Donald sebagai saksi dalam persidangan. Donald tidak memberikan kesaksiannya pada persidangan yang pertama dan menggunakan jeda yang panjang dalam proses percakapan tersebut.

Fungsi bahasa yang sering digunakan dalam komik Donald Duck adalah *referential function*. karena komik ini menceritakan tentang perampokan yang membutuhkan informasi dalam proses investigasi.

Penulis menyarankan kepada peneliti selanjutnya untuk menggunakan sasaran yang berbeda seperti halnya dalam novel atau film untuk memperkaya teori tentang gaya percakapan dan fungsi bahasa.

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
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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter discusses about the background of the study, research problems, objectives of the study, and definition of the key terms.

1.1 Background of Study

Pragmatics is the study of language as the use of language is crucial to understand between speakers (writers) or hearers (readers) because every person has different interpretation in his or her minds. Yule (1996:3) states that “Pragmatics is concerned with the study of meaning as communicated by a speaker (or writer) and interpreted by a listener (or reader)”. In linguistics, Dearborn (2005:869) states that “pragmatics deals with verbal signs (words, utterances, texts) and how they are used by humans in communication”. Therefore, to understand pragmatics more studies are needed to understand the meaning and also context which are used at a time. Grundy (2000:72) states that there are three things to understand pragmatic meaning involve identifying a context that will make sense of an utterance, they are: deictic context, speech act context, and implicature context. . . In case of implicature, context helps us to determine what is conveyed implicitly but not explicitly stated by the speaker.

Conversations among human beings are necessary for life. Conversation can occur anytime and anywhere we are. Cook (1989:51) says that speaker somehow defines the term “talk” as conversation when: “it is not primarily necessitated by a

practical task; any unequal power of participants is partially suspended, the number of participants is small; turns are quite short, and talk is primarily for the participants and not for an outside audience”. In addition, Cook (1989:55) says that “conversation is constructed and executed as it happens, by two people, feeling their ways forward together”. Understanding every conversation should be owned by everyone in order to make our interlocutor understand about what we are taking about. Therefore, we must know about the background, and education of our interlocutors. To understand the meaning of the language is not only by knowing its meaning but also by drawing conclusion on what has been delivered. In comic, the reader should draw the message which is delivered by the writer.

Comics are defined as a pictorial story which is favored by children. In Indonesia, children prefer reading comics rather than other story books. With a pictorial story, children can combine their understanding from the sentence with the displayed picture. A comic strip is defined as “a sequence of drawings arranged in interrelated panels to display brief humor or to form narratives, often serialized, with text in balloons and captions” (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/_Comic_strip). It could be inferred that comics can accelerate understanding of the story. Comics are loved by many people including kids and also young people. In Indonesia there are many comics which have been translated from the original languages into Bahasa Indonesia. Many kinds of comics circulated in Bahasa Indonesia include comics from Japan, Malaysia, Indonesia, America and other countries. One of the comic which comes from America is a Donald Duck.

Donald Duck is a cartoon character created in 1934 at Walt Disney Productions and licensed by Walt Disney Company (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Donald_Duck).

Walt Disney itself created a lot of comics, such as Spiderman, Batman, Superman and etc. Donald typically wears a sailor suit with a cap and a black or red bow tie.

Besides, Kwik, Kwek, and Kwak are the other three main characters that appear in Disney cartoons and comic books published by Disney Company. They are the nephews of Donald Duck. Kwik, Kwek, and Kwak can be distinguished from the hats which are used. Kwik usually wears a red hat, Kwek usually wears a blue hat, and Kwak usually wears green hat.

This study analyzes the conversation styles and language functions in some utterances based on the theme which are used by the main characters in Donald Duck comic. This study applies Yule's theory that is conducted in Pragmatics and Cook's theory about Discourse Analysis. The significant of the study is to help the speaker and the listener understand about the conversation in terms of the styles and functions in order to make the conversation easier to understand. Every speaker and hearer will produce the turns from the utterances which are used in the conversation. It happens because the basic of conversation is the turn. Mey (2001:139) says that the basic unit of the conversation is the turn. In addition, the writer analyzed the functions which are found in the conversation because every utterance conveyed by speakers has a meaning.

The writer limits her research only by analyzing the utterances by the main characters in Donald Duck comic because they become the dominant figures in the

story. Sudjiman quoted by Abdi (2011:14) states that “major character is the dominant figure that often appears and major concerns of the story”. The writer chooses **26th edition** because there are many new terms which are conveyed by the writer related to moral values. In this comic, Donald Duck wants becomes the witness for a crime of a bank robbery. From that way, Donald then often receives a threat from Gattino gang in his life and his family. This is a good example for all people in to be brave as a witness. Furthermore, the writer used this edition as the latest comic edition in the period when this thesis is written.

This research is expected to give reference and contribution in pragmatics area, especially in developing and analyzing the styles which are used in utterances. The result of this research is expected to be able to give valuable contribution for Brawijaya University especially in English study program. It could be used as additional information to get better understanding about conversation style for writers, readers, and lecturers. In addition, this research is expected to develop the readers’ ability when they make conversation with their interlocutor. The readers can know the style which is used in conversations and the message conveyed by the speaker. The result of this research is also expected to enrich the readers’ understanding on the conversation analysis especially in conversation styles and language functions. Moreover, the writer expects the present research could give valuable input for the next researchers in doing similar studies especially in turn-taking in comic strip.

1.2 Problems of the Study

Based on the background of the study, the problems of the study are formulated as follows

1. What are the conversation styles used by the main characters in “Donald Duck” Walt Disney comic?
2. What are the language functions used by the main characters in “Donald Duck” Walt Disney comic?

1.3 Objectives of the Study

The objectives of the study are:

1. To describe the kinds of conversation styles which are used by the main characters in “Donald Duck” Walt Disney comic.
2. To find out the language functions are used by the main characters in “Donald Duck” Walt Disney comic.

1.4 Definition of Key Terms

To avoid misunderstanding, it is necessary to define and give some explanations about the term used in this thesis. The definition of the key terms is stated bellow:

Pragmatics : the study of the ability of language users to pair sentences with the contexts in which they would be appropriate. Levinson (1983: 24).


Conversation : the way in which people socialize and develop and sustain their relationships with each other. Liddicoat (2007: 1).

Conversation Style : the function of paralinguistic and prosodic features, which he calls contextualization cues, to maintain thematic cohesion and signal how conversational contributions are intended. Lakoff as quoted by Tannen (1987:251)

Language functions : formal meaning of what is said or written and consider what the sender of a message intends to achieve with it. Cook (1989:24)

Donald Duck : a popular cartoon created by Walt Disney.

Comic : narrative form that combine written texts and pictorial elements. Mey (2009:80).



CHAPTER II

REVIEW RELATED LITERATURE

This chapter presents some theories and references help to analyze the problems of the research, which are includes: the definition of pragmatics, context, conversation analysis, conversational styles, and language functions.

2.1 Pragmatics

Many Pragmatics scholars give their opinion on the definition of Pragmatics, such as Yule (1996: 3) states that pragmatics concerns with the study of meaning which is communicated by the speaker (or writer) and interpreted by a listener (or reader). In addition Levinson (1983:9) states that pragmatics is the study of relations between language and context that are grammaticalized, or encoded in the structure of a language. Here, context is closely related to pragmatics field in understanding the languages which are conveyed by the speaker.

2.2 Context

Context is closely related to pragmatic field. When we are talking to our opponent, we must know who, where, when, what and how the conversation is going on. Hymes as quoted by Titscher (2000:157) states that the factors that indicate the component in a speech event can be interpreted as features of context that can be

understood as initial framework. The features of context are presented in the table below

2.3 Conversation Analysis

Mey (2009: 132) says that conversation analysis (CA) is the study on the methods of participants oriented when they organize social action through talk. It investigates rules and practices from an interaction perspective and studies them by examining recordings of real-life interactions. CA concerns on the organization of talk as situated, socially organized sets of practices. It describes the methods members use for organizing talk as interactional structures that both shape the context in which

they operate and enable its orderly, internationally coordinated progression. Then in conversation analysis, we are trying to interpret the situation and the message which are conveyed by the members of society itself.

Liddicoat (2007:51) says that one of the most noticeable features of conversation is that speakers change. When we are doing conversation with our interlocutor there is a change of the turn between them. Usually in the social life, the participants know when they have turn to speak. Sometimes, we have already used our turn to speak in the conversation. The examples of the signal that used to take the turn are eye context, falling intonation, and pause. Mey (2009:135) says that Conversationalists use specific techniques to allocate next turn. If current speaker select another participant as next speaker before her turn has arrived at its first possible completion point (other selection), the selected party has both the right and the obligation to begin the next turn at this point. If no other speaker is selected, another participant may self-select as next speaker. If none of these options is used, current speaker may continue. The system then applies again as soon as current speaker arrives at the next possible completion point.

From the turn which is used by the speakers, the writer wants to analyze the style of conversation used by the main characters in Donald Duck. The writer uses the turn to analyze the style because with the turn, the conversation will be complete. There is a relation between one turn and other turns. Liddicoat (2007:107) states that the basic sequence is closely linked to the turn-taking system itself because it makes speaker change a relevant next action.

2.4 Conversation Style

Yule (1996:76) says about the features which characterize the turn-taking system of conversations invested with meaning by their users. Even within a broadly defined community of speakers, there is often sufficient variation to cause potential misunderstanding. There are two kinds of conversational styles when the participant doing the conversation.

1. Some individuals expect that participation in a conversation will be very active, that speaking rate will relatively fast, with almost no pausing between turns. This conversational style has been called a **high involvement style**. For example:

Bill : have you eaten?	}	The conversation immediately discharge If they use this style.
Anna : yes I have.		

2. It refers substantially from another style in which speakers use a slower rate, expect longer pauses between turn, do not overlap, and avoid interrupting or completion of the other's turns. This non-interrupting, non-imposing style has been called a **high considerateness style**. For example:

Bill :W-What do you want	}	the speaker speak slowly with the pause in conversation to block the interruption people
Anna :We've just to get and advice		

Yule, (1996:76) says that a speaker who typically uses the first style gets into a conversation with a speaker who normally uses the second style, the talk tends to become one-side. The active participation style will tend to overwhelm the other

style. Neither speaker will necessarily recognize that it is the conversational styles that are slightly different. Instead, the more rapid-fire speaker may think the slower paced speaker just does not have much to say, is shy and perhaps boring or even stupid. In return, he or she is likely to be viewed as noisy, pushy, domineering, selfish, and even tiresome. Features of conversational style will often be interpreted as personality traits.

2.5 Language Function

To discover how such inferences are made Cook (1989:24) states that firstly we will need to examine the range of possible functions of language and secondly to try to understand how people correctly interpret them. Understanding this connection between the form and the function of language will help us to explain how stretches of language is.

The clearest and most influential theory was formulated by Jakobson (1960) and further theories developed by Hymes (1962) as quoted by Cook (1989:25) the following are the elements of communication.

1. The emotive function :communicating the inner states and emotions of the addresser ('Oh no!', 'Fantastic!', 'Ugh!', and swear words used as exclamations).

2. The directive function :seeking to affect the behavior of the addresser (please help me!, 'Shut up!', 'I'm warning you').

3. The phatic function :opening the channel or checking that is working either for social reasons ('Can you hear me?', 'Are you still there?', 'Can you see the blackboard from the back of the room?,' 'Can you read my writing?')

4. The poetic function :in which the particular from chosen is the essence of the message (the advertising slogan BEANZ MEANZ HEINZ would lose its point if it were paraphrased as 'if you are buying beans, you will naturally buy Heinz')

5. The referential function :carrying information, such as giving the information on the bank robbery in the court.

6. The metalinguistic Function:focusing attention upon the code itself, to clarify it or renegotiate it ('What does this word here mean?', 'This bone is known as the "femur", "Will" and " Shall" mean the same thing nowadays') this book has largely metalinguistic function.

7. The contextual function :creating a particular kind of communication ('Right, let's start the lecture', 'It's just a game').

2.6 Previous Studies

There are have been some research on conversation analysis from different perspectives. Adhalina (2011) has conducted research about the language style differences between the students and teachers. This research uses descriptive qualitative method and uses Holmes theory. In her research she states that the students use casual style and the teachers use formal style. The language differences are influenced by non-linguistic factor. Therefore, in this research the writer does not find the language function differences between the students and teachers.

Another study is conducted by Anggraeni (2011) about the types of speech acts, the functions of speech acts and how speech acts are performed by the main characters. This research uses descriptive qualitative method and uses Searle in Schiffrin theory for the type of speech act, and Leech theory for the function of speech acts. The writer found that the main characters use all types of the speech act in their utterances. They are directives, commissives, representatives, declaratives, and expressive. Furthermore, there are four functions of illocutionary act produced by the main characters. They are convivial, competitive, conflictive, and collaborative. In addition, it is found that speech acts are directly (literary) and indirectly (non-literary) performed by the main characters.

This research analyzes the conversation analysis which focusing on the conversation styles and language functions used by the main characters in Donald Duck comic especially in 26th edition. The writer analyzed the styles and functions used by Donald Duck, Kwek, Kwak, Kwik in the comic.

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

This chapter presents the research method used by the writer in doing her research. It concerns research design, data sources, data collection, and data analysis.

3.1 Research Design

The suitable research design of this study is descriptive qualitative based on its purpose and type of the data. It is called qualitative research because this research describes about the utterances which are produced by the main characters in Donald Duck Walt Disney comic. This research is classified into qualitative because the writer analyses the result of the data analysis in the form of words rather than numbers. Ary (2004:471) says that the researcher should describe the approach taken in the analysis of the data. Qualitative research aims to gain an authentic understanding of the experiences of the people, as perceived by the people concerned.

Bungin (2001:66) says that “Qualitative analysis was used to analyze the meaning of the data which appears on the surface”.

In addition, the writer uses qualitative data because the data are the utterances in Donald Duck comics. Ary et.al (2002:470) says that interpreting qualitative data is difficult, because there are no set of rules to follow. The quality of the interpretation

depends on the background, perspective, knowledge, and theoretical orientation of the research and the intellectual skills that she brings to the task.

3.2 Data Source

This study focuses on the conversation styles and language functions used in Donald Duck's conversation. The data source of this study is the English comic of Donald Duck published in 26th edition because the previous edition was the latest comic during this thesis writing process. From the data source, the writer analyzed and investigated the styles and language functions in Donald Duck's conversations which are used by the main characters in the comic. The writer chose this comic because this comic gives moral value messages, such as criticizing political irony.

This comic tells about Donald Duck who wants to be a witness for bank robbery, which is a good example for all people in the world, to be brave as a witness.

3.3 Data Collection

The writer collected the data by using document analysis. The writer uses several steps to collect the data as follows:

- a. Reading the comic for several times.
- b. Classifying Donald Duck comic conversations based on the theme which is used by the main characters for each turn.
- c. Analyzing the conversations based on the style and function.

3.4 Data Analysis

After getting the data, the writer analyzed the data as the follows:

- a. Reading the conversations which are produced by the main characters based on the theme.
- b. Analyzing the data based on the styles which are used by the main characters based on the theme.
- c. Describing the data in order to give explanation about the styles.
- d. Making conclusion by describing the result of the research.
- e. Analyzing the data based on theme of the conversations.
- f. Finding the context based on the theme of the conversations, and then finding the language functions which are used in the conversations.
- g. Describing the data in order to give explanation about the functions.
- h. Making conclusion by describing the result of the research.

CHAPTER IV

FINDINGS AND DISCUSSIONS

This chapter presents analysis of the data obtained from the data sources. The writer classified the data description based on the research problems, findings the conversation styles based on the turn, and then analyzed the language functions used in the conversations.

4.1 Findings

From the comic, the writer found 16 conversations that fulfill the requirement the conversation styles used by the main characters in Donald Duck comic strip. The utterances were divided into two different analyses. The first is about conversation styles and the next is about language functions used by the main characters in the conversations.

4.1.1 Analysis of Conversation Style Used Main Characters

In Donald Duck comic strip, the writer found the conversation styles which were used by the main characters. The writer analyzed the data based on the styles which are used by the main characters. The analysis was divided into two types of conversations, as follows

4.1.1.1 High Involvement Style

Data 1.1

Gattino Gang 1 : c'mon guys! Go, go, go!
 Gattino Gang 2 : ha ha! Did you see the look on their faces?
 Sometimes it's enough simply to be at the wrong place at the wrong time for trouble to star.
 Donald : whoa!
 Gattino Gang 1 : Argh! Splat!
 Gattino Gang 2 : get up! And get in the car!
 Gattino Gang 1 : Dang! *That duck saw my face!*
 Gattino Gang 2 : we'll deal with it later!
 Bank owner : robbers! We've been robbed! Where did they go?
 Donald : they drove that way!

From the conversations above, the conversational style which was shown in the comic is **high involvement style**. Those conversations are included as high involvement style because, when a robbery happened in the bank, the robbers did some important conversations for saving the time. In the utterance, "that duck saw my face!" , means that the robbers were in hurry in their utterance. From the conversation above, it can be seen that actually all of the utterances are displayed in the data 1.1 are included as high involvement style. Then, the writer took the utterance "that duck saw my face!" as the example of **high involvement style**.

Data 1.2

Toby Chief : please have a look in these Criminals' Photo Albums and see if you recognize your guy!
 Donald Duck : Bring them on!
 Ghost! I never knew there were this many broken noses and cauliflower ears in the world!
 Toby Chief : oh, there are 10 shelves of albums more!
 Donald Duck : *it was him! That's the guy I saw!*
 Toby Chief : I knew it! Wally Gattino ! One of the thugs in the Gattino Gang!
 Bill! Bob! To the Squad Car! I want you to go and arrest Wally Gattino!
 Bill, Bob : aye aye, chief!

From the conversations above, the conversational style which was shown in the comic is **high involvement style**. This conversation is included as high involvement

style because the speaker and listener spoke quickly. This is proven when Toby Chief took the criminals' photo album files to Donald. According to Toby Chief, the robber's photograph was on the criminals' photo album files. So that, the conversation happened very quickly. When Donald looked at the photo and found who the criminal was, he directly provides feedback to the listener or Toby chief. In the utterance, "it was him! that's the guy I saw!" showed that Donald had been found the criminals who robbed the bank. From that conversation, the writer found that actually all the utterances which were displayed in the data 1.2 are included as high involvement style. Then, the writer took the utterance "it was him! that's the guy I saw!" as the example of **high involvement style**.

Data 1.3

Donald Duck : you know where they live?
 Toby Chief : *sure! We watch them regularly!* we just don't find any evidence against them or witnesses who will testify!

After analyzing the conversations above based on the functions which were used in Donald Duck comic, the main characters used seven kinds of language functions, those are: emotive function, directive function, poetic function, referential function, metalinguistic function, and contextual function. For getting detail information about the use of language function, the writer discussed in 4.2 below.

4.2 Discussion

This section discusses about the findings of this study. From the findings, the writer found conversational styles and language functions used by the main characters in the "Donald Duck" comic. It is found that the main characters used all types of conversation styles.

The first type is **high involvement style** which was used by main characters when the conversation was done quickly and correctly. There was no pause or interruption in the conversation. According to Yule (1996:76) high involvement style occurs when some individuals expect that participation in a conversation will be very active, that speaking rate will relatively fast, with almost no pausing between turn. Data 1.10, shows when Donald gave his testimony in the second court and received witness protection program from Toby chief. The participants involved in this conversation are Donald, Kwek, Kwik, and Kwak. This conversation occurred in the afternoon when his nephew went home from school. Donald was scared with Gattino gang's threat, but his nephew advised him to get along with their new neighbors.

From the conversation above, it can be seen that Donald talked to himself quickly to cover his own fear. The utterance, "I bet they are just waiting till my nerves are so kaput I can punch a hole in a wet newspaper!" indicates that Donald was scared from the threat purposed to him.

Furthermore, the main characters used this conversation style when the speaker spoke less than the listener. In other words, the listener took more turns in this conversation style. As in the data 1.8, Donald gave his testimony in the second court.

The participants who involved in the conversations were Donald, Gattino gang, and Reporters. This conversation occurred in the morning in front of the court. The condition was very confusing because the reporters asked Donald's reason for testifying in the second court. Besides, Donald was also scared of Gattino gang's threat after giving his testimony. The reporters chased Donald and asked many questions related to his testimony in the court. Donald did not say anything and Toby chief asked Donald to go to the car, so Donald did not have to answer the reporter's question. The utterance "get in the car Donald" showed that Toby chief helped Donald to avoid the reporters' questions.

The second style **high considerateness style** was used by main characters, so the chance to speak is not taken by the interlocutor. The main characters used long pause to postpone the talks for a while in order not to be taken by his opponent. According to Yule (1996:76) high considerateness style occurs when speakers use a slower rate, expect longer pauses between turn, do not overlap, and avoid interrupting or completion of the other's turn. As provided in 2.3, when Donald and his family came

into a new house that given by Toby chief, Kwek expressed his admiration to Donald.

The participants involved in these conversations were Donlad, Kwik, Kwak, and Kwek. This conversation occurred in the morning, in Donald’s new house. The condition at that time was comfortable because Donald and his nephew came into their new house. They were happy after getting a new house and a car. Besides, Donald also warned by his nephews to be watchful with any danger which will come to them. The utterance "you look real suave with new 'do, Unca Don er, Unca Quincy ". Kwek used er, in the conversation as the filler in order to make his interlocutor did not take the conversation.

The most common style used in the conversation in “Donald Duck comic” was **high involvement style**. The comic told about the robbery happening in a bank. Thus, the conversation deals with some investigation to reveal the crime that happened in the bank. With this conversation style, the speakers and the listeners were very active in their conversation process.

After analyzing the comic, the writer found some conversation which did not follow the rules adhered to the process of conversation. There were some questions that were delivered by the speaker, but there was no response from the interlocutor. It can be seen from the data 1.3 from the utterance "That's how easy it is to catch a bank robber?" it can be seen that it is a retrieval question or question that does not need any response from the listeners, so after saying the utterance Toby chief did not get response from his interlocutor. Furthermore, it is also found in the data 1.6 in utterance "Did I raise you to be such a model citizens?" when Donald ensured his

family when Donald became a witnesses that he must take the risk for getting a treat from Gattino gang.

There are seven language functions used in a communication. They are emotive function, directive function, poetic function, referential function, metalinguistic function, contextual function, and phatic function. From the main characters utterance found in "Donald Duck comic strip", the writer found that there are six language functions used.

The first language function **emotive function** which was used by the speaker to express their feelings on the certain condition. According to Cook (1989:25 emotive function was communicating the inner states and emotions of the addresser. Data 1.1 it that the participants used emotive function to express his feelings when one of Gattino gang fell. The participants involved in the conversation are Donald, Gattino gang, and bank owner. This conversation happened in the morning in the bank. The condition that occurred at that time was panic became by the bank owner ran away when he saw the robbers. Apart from that, Donald was also surprised because one of Gattino's man was spotted by Donald when they tried to bring the goods to the car. Donald was surprised to see one of the robbers fell and dropped the mask that he used. The utterance, **"that duck saw my face!"** "proved that Donald was shocked to see the robber's face. In addition, the emotive functions are also in the data 1.3, 1.8, 1.10, and 1.12.

Along with the analysis of conversation styles and language functions, the writer found the relationship between those two. It could be seen from emotive function

included in high involvement style because when the participants in the conversation used active and quick style, they showed their feeling at the same time. For example, as in 1.12 when Donald and his family had returned to their old house, Kwik, and Kwek used high involvement actively and expressed their feeling when they have to return to their old life with living in small house.

The second language function is **directive function** used by the speaker when it affected their behavior. According to Cook (1989:25) directive function is seeking to affect the behavior of the addresser. As showed in 1.4 the participants used directive when the speaker tried to influence the addresser's behavior. The Participants involved in the conversation are Donald, Kwik, kwek, and Kwak. This conversation happened in the afternoon, in Donald house. Donald was scared because he and his family were under Gattino's gang threat. Donald was so scared because Gattino gang came to his house and ravaged Donald's dinner with his nephews. Kwik, kwek, and Kwak were also surprised to see Gattino gang intimidated Donald in their house.

This conversation used directive function to alert the addresser. In the utterance **"Keep your mouth shut or we'll we find you!"** that Donald was treated by Gattino gang that affecting his behavior change.

Based on the analysis of conversation style and language function, the writer found the relationship between those two. It could be seen from directive function included as high involvement style. It happened because when the participants had a conversation actively and quickly. They used directive function to threaten Donald

for not giving his testimony in the court. When Gattino gang threatened Donald, he used proper, clear, and quick language.

The third language function **phatic function** which was used for open a channel in the social reason. Cook (1989:25) states that opening the channel or checking is working either for social reasons. The participants used phatic function to ask Donald's rapidly in order to get Donald testimony in the first court. The example can be seen in data 1.14. The participants involved to the conversations were Donald, lawyer, judge, Wally Gattino, and Toby chief. This conversation happened in the morning in the court. The condition was fearful because Donald was confused on what should be delivered in the first court. When the lawyer gave many questions to Donald, he did not answer the question according to what he saw but he disproved varied reasons in the court. The utterance "er.... It was pitch dark and I wore my shades..." and "er.... My contact lenses were foggy!" that Donald seemed confused to the answer the testimony. Donald did not give his testimony so that it made Toby chief wondered that Donald was betrayed.

Along the analysis process of conversation style and language function, the writer found there is a relation between them. It could be seen from the phatic function included in high considerateness style. It used phatic function to check that the channel is working for social reasons. The data 2.2 used high considerateness style when Donald did not give testimony in the first court. Then the lawyer had to ask Donald for many times in order to get the answer for his question using phatic

function to check that the channel is working either for social reasons or not. Finally,

Donald said that his eyes were foggy so that he could not see clearly.

The fourth language function is **poetic function** used by a speaker to convey a message in the form of proverbs. It is usually used in the form of poetry. According

to Cook (1989:25) poetic function is a particular form chosen which becomes the essence of the message. The participants use poetic function to reveal a proverb or a

slogan. The example can be seen in data 1.9. The participants who are involved in the conversation were Donald Kwik, Kwek, Kwak, Garbage man, and Mailman. This

conversation happened in the morning in Donald's house. The condition was apprehensive because of a threat which came to him and his family disturbed his life.

Donald was scared to know that the garbage man and the Mailman threatened his family as garbage collector and sent some letters to his house. This conversation used

poetic function to reveal on his experience in a proverb. The utterance **"I still feel like a man on the moon"** means Donald did not believe in the reality. Donald still

considered himself like a hero because he was a witness in the court. In fact, they should be careful with the threat that came from Gattino gang.

From the analysis of conversation style and language function, the writer found the relationship between those two. It could be seen from the poetic function included

in high involvement style because the participants used active style and they used poetic function to express their feeling into a proverb. When Donald and his family

were threatened, Donald expressed his feeling by using a proverb. By using a proverb, Donald stated his admiration to himself as a witness who became the hero in the bank

robbery. In fact, after his testimony in the court, Donald must take the risk that is being threatened by Gattino gang.

The fifth language function is **referential function** used by the speaker to provide information. Referential function is widely used in comics because the investigation requires information from several witnesses who are needed to reveal a crime.

According to Cook (1989:25) referential function carries information. Data 1.2 shows when the participants used referential function to inform someone. The participants were Donald, Toby chief, Bill, and Bob and this conversation happened in the morning at the police station. The Condition at that time was serious because Donald tried to find and to recognize the bank robber's face in the criminal photo album.

Toby chief gave criminals photo album collection to Donald to recognize the criminal's face. After Donald recognized the criminal's face, Toby chief ordered Bill and Bob to catch him. Thus, this conversation used referential function to disclose a bank robbery investigation. From the utterance, "it was him! that's the guy I saw " it could be seen that Donald recognized bank robbery's face in criminal photo collection. Furthermore, referential also is used in the data 1.6, 1.7, 1.13, 1.11 and 1.16.

Based on the analysis of conversation style and language function, the writer found that there are relationships between them. It could be seen that mostly used is high involvement style rather than high considerateness style that included as referential function. As in the data 1.6, 1.11 and 1.7 those utterances used high involvement style actively since Donald tried to provide information as a witness and

as an uncle who gave the information to his nephew. While the data 2.1 and 2.4 used high considerateness style to provide information in panic situation such as when Donald became a witness in the first court and when he was chased by Gattino gang after that.

The sixth language function was **metalinguistic function** used by the speaker to clarify or renegotiate the things needed in a conversation. According to Cook (1989:25) metalinguistic function focuses on attention upon the code itself, clarified or renegotiated as for example in data 1.5. The participants who were involved to the conversation were Donald, Toby chief and they used metalinguistic function. This conversation happened in the morning at the police station and the situation was confusing because in first court Donald did not give any testimony about the bank robbery because he was threatened by Gattino gang, then Toby chief offered a house and car so that Donald gave his testimony in the second court. Donald was confused on what should he decided, While Toby chief constantly persuaded him to be the witness. The utterance, "I'd like to show you a picture of your new house! And in **and your new car!**" indicates that Toby chief tried to make a deal with Donald by giving him a new house and car.

From the analysis process of conversation styles and language functions, the writer found a relation between them. It could be seen from directive function included as high considerateness style. It used metalinguistic function to clarify or renegotiate something. The data 2.2 used high considerateness style when Donald did

not give testimony in the first court. Donald admitted that his eyes were foggy so that he could not see clearly.

The last language function is **contextual function** used by the speaker when he or she builds a communication with the other. According to Cook (1989:25) contextual function creates a particular kind of communication as in 1.13 that the participants used contextual function to create a particular kind of communication. The participants involved in the conversation are Donald, Kwek, Kwik, and Kwak. This conversation occurred in the morning at Donald's new house. The situation was happy because Donald and his family moved to their new house in Turkey town.

Donald and his nephews really like their new house but Donald always warned his nephew to always be careful. The previous situation could be proven by uttering **"chief Toby says it's better to wear a disguise while my picture's still in the news!"**

it could be inferred that Donald warned his family to know their surroundings.

Along the analysis process of conversation style and language function, the writer found there is a relation between them. It could be seen from the contextual function included in high considerateness style because the participants in the conversation used high considerateness style in contextual function to create communication.

When Donald and his family come in their new house, they had disguise in order not to be detected by Gattino gang.

After analyzing the conversation in "Donald Duck" comic, the writer found that conversation styles used by the main characters are high involvement style and high considerateness style. The examples of high involvement style can be found in the

data 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6, 1.7, 1.8, 1.9, 1.10, 1.11, and 1.12, while the examples of high considerateness style can be found in data 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, and 2.4.


Furthermore, language function used by the main characters in “Donald Duck” comic are emotive function, directive function, referential function, metalinguistic function, poetic function, and contextual function. Emotive function occurred in data 1.1, 1.3, 1.8, 1.10, 1.11, and 1.12, directive function in 1.4, phatic function in 1.14, poetic function in 1.9, metalinguistic function in 1.5, contextual function in 1.15 and referential function in 1.2, 1.6, 1.7, 1.13, and 1.16.

Different from the previous studies, this study focuses on conversation analysis used by the main characters in “Donald Duck Walt Disney comic strip to find out the conversational styles and the language functions used by the main characters of Donald Duck while the previous study in Adhalina (2011) focused on the different language styles and language functions between students and teachers in updating their status in Facebook webpage based on Holmes’ theory, which are expressive, directive, referential, metalinguistic, poetic and phatic. Moreover, in Anggraeni (2011) focus on speech acts used by the main characters in comic “Spongebob Squarepants”, analyzing the type of speech acts, the functions of speech acts, and describing speech acts performed by the main characters in comic “Spongebob Squarepants”.

The result of this research has differences from the studies before conducted in the field of language style and speech acts. This research investigated conversation styles and language functions which used in the Donald Duck comic strip. The most

common conversation styles used was high involvement style rather than high considerateness style because the content of story told about an investigation related to bank robbery. That way, language functions which were used by the main characters were active and clear. In addition, the most common language functions used was referential function because the story in the comic told about investigation and need a lot of the information from the relevant Participants.

By analyzing conversation styles and language functions in the comic, the writer could find new finding about the phenomena of conversation styles and language functions which is different from the previous studies. So the writer could say that this study is different from the previous studies and this study could enrich the information about conversation styles and language functions used by the main characters of Donald Duck Walt Disney comic that would be valuable for the readers.



CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents conclusion of the research and the suggestion for the next research.

5.1 Conclusion

This study was conducted to identify the conversation analysis performed by the main characters in Donald Duck comic. The writer found 16 conversations which were included into the conversation styles and language functions. From the finding, the conversation style which is often used in the comic is high involvement style.

This is style used by the main characters actively and clearly. When the speaker and the listener have the same time to take the floor to speak, then the conversation will be running smoothly, with almost no pause or interruption between the speakers. The next is about language functions used in the comic are emotive function and referential function. The emotive function is shown in the comic when Donald is the only person who saw the robbers of bank. The referential function is shown in the comic when Donald gave the information in the investigation process, such as in the court, when Donald became a witness giving the information that the criminal who robbed the bank was Wally Gattino.

From the analysis the writer found 12 conversations using high involvement style and 4 conversations high considerateness style. In addition, the writer also found 5

emotive function, 6 conversations referential function, 1 conversation directive function, 1 conversation phatic function, 1 conversation poetic function, 1 conversation metalinguistic function, and 1 conversation contextual function.

5.2 Suggestion

This research was conducted to analyze conversation used by the main characters in Donald Duck comic. Therefore, the writer suggests to the reader and the next researchers to conduct deeper analysis by using different objects with the same theory, such as analyzing film with the same theory. The next researchers are also able to analyze the conversation styles and language functions based on the film because the researchers can combine between facial expressions with the words produced by each actor. Hopefully, this research can also become guidance, inspiration and be useful for the next researchers who are interested in doing further research in this area by using different data sources for their research. Finally, it can be a reference to conduct the next research in the area of pragmatic.

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
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
