

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

From the research findings and discussion that have been elaborated in the previous chapter, it can be concluded that the study concerned on type of speech act used by male and female character, and speaking context in the movies.

Based on the analysis, the conclusions were stated as the following:

- According to the analysis of all the three scenes, they indicate that male characters tend to use many representatives. It refers to the data that shows the total usage of representative of all the scenes is 46 utterances from total 142 utterances that have been analyzed. In the other hand, the female prefer to use many expressive, it is shown from the data that in all the scenes male characters use 25 utterances that containing expressive were found out of 71 utterances.

Related with the speaking context that were analyzed, the writer found 9 (nine) contexts from three selected scenes, which are 3 (three) contexts in the scene number four, 2 (two) context found in the scene number twenty, and 4 (four) contexts found in the scene number thirty nine

- Based on the analysis from the speech acts data based on the gender differences, the writer concludes that there is no significant difference of the speech acts used between male and female characters in the first

and second scenes that were chosen by the writer. Meanwhile, In the third scene, the writer found a significance difference of the speech acts usage by male and female characters in the movie.

5.2 Suggestion

Although it is shown that the writer already answer two problems of the study, this study also has some weaknesses. Therefore, there are some suggestions that the writer would suggest to the next researchers who will deal with the same field of study that the writer chose. The first, the writer suggests that the feature researcher can find out more references from experts' theories to support him/her in analyzing the data. If the data is analyzed with more theory, then the data will show more phenomena that can also be analyzed by other theories that relate to one another.

The second, the writer suggest to future researcher to choose more than 3 (three) scenes to get to get a more varied data related to male and female character in the movie. Since this study also analyzed the speech acts used by male and female character in the movie, it is better if the future researcher can find some scene that are have a big number of male and female characters that will be analyzed. Thus, the data finding from the study also will be more rich and reliable.
