

## **CHAPTER IV**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

This chapter presents about the conclusion of the analysis on the death of superhero portrayed in Batman v Superman: Dawn of Justice film and also give a suggestion for a further researcher who wants to conduct similar a research with this study.

#### **1.1. Conclusion**

Superheroes are figures with extraordinary abilities and power. Their spectacular strength can be seen in most comics and films. Their bodies are depicted to be super strong and muscular- in both male and female superheroes- and they commonly live a long life. Under their action on the battlefield, superheroes have met many problems and enemies which resemble them in terms of strength or appearance. This is the reason why the factors which can make them dead are important informations to know how to beat them.

Based on the finding and discussion in this research, there are five factors that can trigger the death of Superhero. That's why Superhero wears a mask and costume for his alter ego. The fourth is the battle between Superhero and Supervillain. There is always the possibility that a hero loses a battle, however, it is of course not shown as often as their victories, like the Superheroes in this film who beaten many time by Doomsday because he is very powerful, even though in the end the Superheroes win the fight. The last factor is Superhero's sacrifice. Sacrifice is sometimes the only thing left to do if a superhero had to face a very powerful villain, like Doomsday in this film and make Superman sacrifices himself by bringing the Kryptonite spear to kill Doomsday and to ultimately die together with him.

The meaning of a superhero's death is a misery and downfall experienced by America behind the internal and external conflicts faced as a great country. *Batman v Superman* film shows Superman's death as the illustration of the loss of democracy in America, where there is no freedom for immigrants to come and live in America, especially for Muslim immigrants.
