

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing the data in the previous chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion and suggestions at the last part of this research. The conclusion is drawn based on the formulated research questions whereas suggestion is intended to provide contribution to the next researcher who is interested in doing further research in this area.

5.1 Conclusion

After collecting the data from source, the writer classified the data based on Reaske and Keraf's theory on the kinds of figurative language used in Adele's songs in 25 album. After the writer classified the data and found some figurative languages used in the album, the writer concluded that there were some types of figurative language to be analyzed.

There are ten types of figurative language found in Adele's songs in 25 album. Those ten figuratives language are hyperbole, simile, metaphor, personification, symbol, metonymy, synecdoche, irony, paradox and apostrophe. The writer cannot found lyrics contain two types of figurative language which are repetition and onomatopoeia. This study shows there are fifty-five lines contains figurative language in this album. There were sixteen hyperboles, five similes, six metaphors, five personifications, eight symbols, three metonymies, one

synecdoche, four irony, six paradox, and one apostrophe. In this study, hyperbole was commonly used by the songwriter in song lyrics in 25 album.

The writer analyze the meaning of the song based on the songwriter thoughts about the songs in her interview provided in trusty media outlet. Based on the songwriter own opinion about the song lyrics, the writer can understand the meaning of the song and categorize which figurative language applied in particular sentences or word.

Furthermore, the figurative language in song lyrics conveys more deeper meaning than literal words. It give variety meaning according to the hearer or reader experience and thoughts. Using figurative language in the songs with unusual and poetic words will give a fresh breath into the song.

5.2 Suggestion

Regarding to the research conducted, there are some suggestions aimed to some parties:

1. For the next researchers

Hopefully, this research becomes an inspiration in writing their thesis. Furthermore, the next researchers who want to continue this study are suggested to use different data sources, such as talk show conversation, direct conversation in daily life, or movie conversation. The researcher also suggests

using another theory of figurative language in order to develop the research of figurative language.

2. For the English Study Program

Since only a few students conduct a research in Relevance theory, the researcher hopes that English Study Program adds more references related to this topic so that the next researcher could present rich literature review that is able to support the analysis of their study.
