

SUMMARY

Beaberlina Mahendra Putri, 2012, **Participative Village Development Planning through Development Planning Consultation (DPC) (A Study in Putren Village, Sukomoro Subdistrict, Nganjuk Regency)**, Drs. The research was conducted based on many criticisms of village development planning on the basis of community that it did not go on the mechanisms of village development planning participation. While a study of a good governance, one of elements was participation, which meant that in the implementation of good governance so public participation included in the development to be highly emphasized. The thesis aimed to describe and analyze the Participative Village Development Planning through Development Planning Consultation (DPC) activity, and also some factors that affected the Putren Village, Sukomoro Subdistrict, Nganjuk Regency.

Type of research is descriptive study with qualitative approach. The analysis method using Miles and Huberman with the support of primary data obtained or collected directly in field because it relates directly to the object. The secondary data sourced outside the words and actions, conduct direct interviews or interviews with an informant in the field so obtain information related to the issues, and observations done by direct observation in the field.

The result of the study showed that the participative village development planning in the Putren Village, Sukomoro Subdictrict had to be done with the Development Planning Consultation (DPC) in order to produce a series of delevopment efforts which aimed for developing village growth, improving skills, creating job opportunity, community development, natural resources (NR) and human resources (HR) management as well as improving public health, infrastructures in the village including transportation, clean water and irrigation condition and also the village government.

To improve further the quality of Development Planning Consultation (DPC), in the production of better village planning documents therefore: 1) public awareness of the importance of Development Planning Consultation (DPC) constantly needs to be built, 2) conducted socialization and solution of problem inventory and 3) to give appreciation to citizens who concern with the village development.
