Village Fund Allocation (VFA) is the right in distributing equalization fund from the City/Local Government in order to improve the service and the public welfare. As the allocation tendency, the VFA's management must run well and with transparency by involving the public to avoid the fraud in managing this program. The aim of this research is to find out, to describe and to analyze the transparency of VFA and the public access for the fund management.

This research based on the descriptive research with qualitative approach. The data source is from the primary and secondary data. The collecting data techniques are observation, interview, and documentation. The analysis methods is interactive model analysis by Miles & Huberman with its data collecting, data reduction, data display, and conclusion drawing.

Based on the research in Pesanggrahan village, Batu, the transparency of VFA is low enough as its less to involve the public in managing the fund. Factors supporting this research is that the level of participation of village officials on high, while the inhibiting factors are (1) lack of public awareness of the participation of development, (2) the lack of information about VFA. The suggestion from this research are: (1) To Involve the publication about all of the activity in managing the VFA; (2) To improve the personnel resources and the community resources; and (3) To hold the training and supervision from the subdistrict and city government.
