SUMMARY

Public Private Partnership (PPP) is a good media in order to increase the social-economy. This partnership provides many advantages and convenience for the company itself, government and communities. If communities only relies to the government to provide a good service provision, it was difficult to achieve because the budget spent are huge, both for development budget and for maintenance budget. With the cooperation between the Local Government and the private sector, the quality and quantity of public facilities will be improved. Besides, this partnership is expected to help the government's role in decreasing inequalities of income and job opportunities in society.
