

ABSTRACT

Labor is the physiological process which allow the change series in a mother to give birth through the birth canal (Yesie, 2010). In every Labor stage, the mother will have some psychological and behavior changes. Basically, every woman will be anxious because of Labor pain. The woman's anxious feeling and behaviour during Labor process are affected by internal factors and external factors. These factors are part of mother's characteristics which affect the Labor pain. The aim of this study was to examine the influence of mother's characteristics on the Labor pain. This study was located in Plaosan Barat street, Blimbing, Malang. The method of study was cross sectional, with total sampling technique. The study was examine the mother's characteristics (age, parity, education, and economy) on the Labor pain by using VAS scale and analyzed with Chi-Square in 95% significance level. The data were collected by giving questionnaire which contains mother's identity and VAS scale. The result showed that more intense labor pain with 9 VAS score in 7 primiparas and the labor pain with 8 score VAS in 3 multiparas on the cervix dilation at 7 cm. Based on the result, it concluded that the mother's characteristics which affected labor pain were parity and education.
