Intellectual women drew parallels between themselves and Universitas slaves. They courageously demanded fundamental reforms, such as the abolition of slavery and women's suffrage, despite social ostracism and versi sometimes financial ruin. Their works were the vanguard of intellectual expression of a larger women's literary tradition that included the
