

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents some conclusions dealing with the results of the study discussed in the previous chapters. It also gives some suggestions which can be used to gain the better insight, especially for the further writers and English Department students.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

Language function is the part of discourse analysis and it aims to smooth the communication between the addresser and the addressee. In a talk show, the language functions produced by the host have the significant role in the process of interview. Through the utterances produced, the host can show and express various functions of the talk that s/he wants to deliver to the guest and viewers.

That's why, the writer is interested to conduct a study that deals with the language functions used by the host in hosting a show. In this study, the writer decided

*Tupperware She Can* as the object and Shahnaz Haque as the subject. The reason is that Shahnaz Haque is a smart host who can bring her program, in which

*Tupperware She Can*, as the only one of women TV program that can be a nominee in Panasonic Gobel Award 2013. In order to analyze the data, the writer used the theory triangulation of Roman Jakobson and M.A.K. Halliday.

The findings from this study shows that Shahnaz Haque uses several types of language function through her utterances in hosting *Tupperware She Can*

Mother's Day 2012 episode. Based on the analysis in the previous chapter, out of seven types of language function, five functions are found in this episode. They are ideational-referential, ideational-metalingual, ideational-phatic, interpersonal-emotive and interpersonal-directive function. The two types of language function mostly used in Shahnaz's utterances are ideational-referential and interpersonal-emotive function. Ideational-referential function is in line with the goal of the conversation. It conveys information and describes something to deliver the purpose of the talk. Interpersonal-emotive function also frequently occurs in Shahnaz's utterances since she often shows her inner state, emotion or feeling directly toward her talk.

The other function quite often used is ideational-metalingual function. Ideational-phatic and interpersonal-directive function are rarely used in Shahnaz's utterances in hosting the program. The two other functions which are absent in the dialogue are poetic and textual function.

Shahnaz Haque also uses some vocabulary choices which have explicit meaning to make her purpose of the talk can be delivered well to the viewer. She uses some words to explain more about something, emphasize her meaning, impress the viewer and express her feeling.

## 5.2 Suggestion

The writer realizes that this study is far from perfect because it took only the host's utterances as the data. The writer expects that this study can contribute to an understanding on how language function is used for the different purpose of



talks in daily life. Therefore, some suggestions are needed to make this thesis better. First, the writer hopes the next writers who are interested in making thesis about discourse analysis especially language function may use other objects for their further research, for example novel, TV serial, newspaper or magazine, etc.

Second, the writer hopes this thesis can be a reference or information for English Department students who are interested to conduct a study concerns on language function. Moreover, English Department students who are interested in analyzing language function or other elements of discourse analysis can use the different theories from the expert of discourse analysis.
