

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing the data in previous chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion and suggestion in the last part of this research. The conclusion is drawn based on the formulated research problem which suggestion is intended to provide literature to the next researcher who interested in doing further research uses Relevance Theory.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

This research is conducted in search of implicature in Megamind movie main character's utterances. The conclusion of this study can be formulated based to the research question. The researcher uses Relevance Theory proposed by Sperber & Wilson (1995) to analyze the data. There are several things which is important in understanding implicature. First, people need to explicate the utterance in order to avoid the ambiguity of the utterances. After explicating the utterances, constructing an appropriate hypothesis about an intended contextual assumption is a must to know the possibility and available meaning of the utterance before concluding the meaning of the utterance.

The writer found 14 utterances uttered from the main character in Megamind movie. The writer concludes implicature happened in conversation between characters in the movie. Those implicature have certain meaning which is not stated directly to the addressee. The implicature were indicated when the addresser stated something which does not relevant to the previous statement

stated by addressee. In other words, the writer draws conclusion that Relevance Theory is concern with ostensive communication that is intentional communication through an addressee that can understand the speaker's thought.

## 5.2 Suggestion

Regarding to the research conducted, there are some suggestion aimed to the next writer and also to the reader.

The writer suggests the next writer especially student of Study Program of English Department in Universitas Brawijaya conduct similar studies to be analyzed using Relevance Theory with different object such as novel, magazine or even article, due to lack of studies concerning about Relevance Theory as the theoretical framework so that the next writer could have wider literature.

The writer also suggests the reader to understand deeply the message conveyed from an utterance to achieve a successful communication.
