

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion related to the analysis of this study and some suggestion concerning this study for the next researcher.

5.1 Conclusion

This study was conducted to find out the word formation processes and the meaning of jargons found in World Beatbox Community website humanbeatbox.com. Based on the data, the writer found 35 (thirty five) jargons used in the articles chosen. The word formation processes used to form those jargons are different. From ten types of word formation processes proposed by Yule, only seven of them are used to form the jargons. Compounding process is mostly used to form the jargons. From 35 (thirty five) jargons, there are 16 (sixteen) jargons categorized as compounding. Meanwhile, 9 (nine) of the total are multiple processes. 3 (three) jargons are coinage, and 3 (three) jargons are acronyms. Then, 2 (two) of them are categorized as borrowing process, 1 (one) jargon is categorized as blending process, and also there is 1 (one) jargon of derivation process.

In addition, the writer also found out the meaning of word formation processes of beatbox jargons in World Beatbox Community website *humanbeatbox.com* by interviewing some experts of beatbox activities to get the valid data about the meaning of beatbox jargons and also more information about beatbox jargons. The experts did not only give information about the meaning of beatbox jargons but also give some important explanations and information related to beatbox activities.

Furthermore, it can be concluded from the findings that beatbox jargons are one of language phenomena that has already existed in society. In beatbox activities, when people have conversation, they use some terms that can only be understood by insiders and it is called jargon. By using jargons, the variation of language develops day by day. In this study, the writer inferred that word formation processes also take important roles in language development.

5.2 Suggestion

The writer realizes that there are many things in this thesis that need improvement. In this study, the writer only focuses on analyzing the jargons found in World Beatbox Community website *humanbeatbox.com*. Through this study, the writer suggests that the next researchers who are interested in Sociolinguistics study, especially jargon, will do more analysis related to jargons.

The writer also suggests the next researchers who are interested in doing further research in this area take the issue not only on jargons in beatbox but also on other popular hobbies. Moreover, it is suggested that further researchers

conduct a study to reveal the reasons of language users to use jargons in communication.
