

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

This chapter presents the research method. It consists of research design, data source, data collection and data analysis.

3.1 Research Design

This research uses qualitative approach. It deals with the data in the form of words. The type of research is document analysis. The data is taken from Indonesia Lawyers Club script. Ary *et al.* (2002) state that “content or document analysis is a research method that is applied to written or visual materials aiming to identify specified characteristics of the material. The materials can be newspapers, television programs, advertisements, or any types of documents.”

This research is qualitative research. The data is analyzed qualitatively without using numbers or statistically tests. The qualitative inquirer deals with data that are in the form of words, rather than numbers and statistics (Ary, 2002, p. 425).

3.2 Data Source

The source of this study is the script of Indonesia Lawyers Club Edition “*Tawuran kok Jadi Budaya?*” video. It is from Indonesia Lawyers Club website on <http://video.tvonenews.tv/program/indonesia-lawyers-club> that was uploaded on October 2nd, 2012.

3.3 Data Collection

Data collection is from document analysis. It is a qualitative research. The researcher collected the data through the following steps below:

1. Download the Indonesia Lawyers Club Edition “*Tawuran kok Jadi Budaya?*” video.
2. Watch the video of Indonesia Lawyers Club Edition “*Tawuran kok Jadi Budaya?*” several times (5 times) to understand the language used in the interpersonal meaning.
3. Translate the participant’s utterances into English.
4. Decide 3 participant’s utterances of Indonesia Lawyers Club Edition “*Tawuran kok Jadi Budaya?*” for the object of the study.
5. Identify the scenes related with participants have been chosen.
6. Make scripts of the participants’ utterances have been chosen as the data of the study in Indonesia Lawyers Club Edition “*Tawuran kok Jadi Budaya?*” video into a written text.

3.4 Data Analysis

In this section, the researcher analyzed all the data through the following steps:

1. Read the data collected.
2. Classify the data based on mood types, using the theory of Halliday.
3. Present the data using a table consisting of number of clause to ease the researcher in knowing the number of clause in data analysis, subject to know

the subject of the utterances, finite to know the finite of clause, tenses to know the tenses and mood to know the mood of utterances, as follows:
